WHEREAS, I, M.A. Cameron

our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-one exhibited his complaint in the Court  
of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Lillian Grant, Cameron Bryant, Grace May Cameron,  
Florence Louise Cameron

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 26th  
day of August 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it  
was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to M.A. Cameron

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman  
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,  
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

M.A. Cameron, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:  
"All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Ward Six of the City  
of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being on corner of Augusta  
Street and Judson Street (now known as Hsynie Street) and being part of lot #One of the  
A.L. Cobb Estate.  
This being the same lot conveyed to Emma T. Beiers by the late W.T. Beiers on Oct. 12th,  
1907, by deed recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., Vol. VVV, at page 608  
and to him by Geo. Brownlee by deed recorded in Vol. VVV, at page 607. See other deeds  
recorded in Vols. TTT, page 39, 000, page 579, UU, page 591 and SS, page 45, and being the  
same lot of land conveyed to M.A. Cameron and Margaret L. Cameron by Emma T. Beiers by  
deed dated June 17, 1913, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State  
aforesaid in Vol. 23, page 229.

appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same;
