All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, near the Judson Mills property and being known and designated as Lots nos. 13 and 14 on plat of property of M.C. Jimison deceased, recorded in the R.M.C. office for the County and State aforesaid in Plat Book "E" at page 161 and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at a corner on Hill street and Road to Judson Mill and running thence along said Road N. 53.55 W. 130 feet to corner of lot no. 12; thence along the line of lot no. 12 S. 42.30 W. 200 feet; thence S. 53.55 E. 130 feet to corner on Hill street; thence along said street N. 42.30 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner."
