HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

P. W. Shockley and his heirs and assigns forever, the  
following described real estate: All those certain pieces  
parcels or lots of land situated in Litch Springs Town-  
ship, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina and  
in the Town of Payson and being known and designated  
as lots nos. 3 and 4 on a subdivision of lot No. 1 property  
of W. M. Shockley, deceased, as shown by sub-division and  
plat of same made by Thos. P. Linder Nov. 10, 1921 and  
recorded in the G. M. C. Office for the County and State  
aforesaid in plat Book "P" at page 20. Lot no. 3 has a  
frontage of 27.9 feet on the South side of the National  
Highway and runs back in parallel lines 141 feet and  
148 feet respectively and has a width in the rear of  
28 feet on the right of way of Southern Railroad and  
lot no. 4 has a frontage of 24.8 feet on the South side  
of the National Highway and runs back in parallel  
lines 140 feet and 140.15 feet respectively with the rear  
line of 28 feet on the right of way of Southern Rail-  
road.
