demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 6th day of March 1924, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Mrs. Edna W. Walker for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. C-983)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$4250.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Mrs. Edna W. Walker, her heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of Mrs. T.M. Bobo, James Bobo, T.M. Bobo and Antrim Bobo, in and to the following described real estate to-wit: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the town of Greer, County and State aforesaid. Beginning at a stone 3x on on Street, running south 37-1/2° West 4.84 chains to a stone 3x; thence North 77-1/2° East 3.37 chains to a stone 3x; thence North 5° West 2.85 to the beginning, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, and bounded on the West by Broad Street; on the East by Randall Street; on the North by lot of Elizabeth T. Westmoreland and being the same lot conveyed to T.M. Bobo by J.S. Burnett by deed recorded in Vol. 666, at page 668, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina".
