Lea Surveyor, Nov. 1st 1911 and recorded in plat  
Book A - at page 524 and being the same lot  
of land conveyed to Thomas Fraizer by W. A.  
Trammell by deed dated October 17, 1914 which  
deed was recorded in the R. M. Co. Office for Greenville  
County in Book Vol. 10 at page 455

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or  
appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same;
