(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Elizabeth Eaton and Theresa McDavid, their heirs and assigns, all of that lot of land situate in Ward 5 East of River Street and on the South side of Cagle Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and is known and designated as lot no. 4 as is shown on plat recorded in Plat Book E, at page 204, it begins on said Cagle Street at a point 130 feet from River Street, fronts Cagle Street forty feet and runs back ninety six feet in parallel lines to the center of the spur track of the C. & W. C. Ry. Company.

The center of the industrial track herinbefore referred to constitutes the dividing line between the lot herein conveyed and the lot heretofore conveyed to Huntington & Beery and it is intended that said industrial track shall be perpetually maintained by the Railway Company for the mutual benefit of the grantee, or grantees, and grantor, their heirs and assigns in order to accomplish said purpose.

The grantor herein does covenant and bind himself, his heirs and assigns that he and they will at all times permit said track to be maintained and operated and will permit all acts that may be necessary to this end, and the grantor does further convey and assign unto the grantees an interest in the right of way with which grantor is vested under and by the terms of the rights of way deeds heretofore made to him to his predecessors in title so as to insure the continued maintenance and operation of said industrial track.
