the grantor hereby doth hereby warrant, bargain, sell and release, and by these presents doth Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. H. Rush, all those certain lots of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid about one and one-half miles northwest of the City of Greenville, on the East side of the Southern Railway, near the American Spinning Company, and known as Lots Nos. 25 and 26, of a survey by W. P. Leagus, July 27th, 1903 of the R.P. Hammett Tract, a plan of which is recorded in the R.L.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, page 68, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Main Line of the Southern Railway track at the west end and southern side of Pinckney Street, and running thence S. 69-45' - one hundred and sixty feet along Pinckney Street to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26; thence N. 20-17' W. one hundred and seventy-one (171) feet and eight (8) inches to an iron pin on a ten foot alley; thence N. 69-45' W. two hundred and fourteen (144) feet and eleven (11) inches along the west side of said alley to an iron pin in center of Main Line of the Southern Railway track; thence N. 38' E. along said track to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

Also, all those other lots on said plat, known as Lots Nos. 26 and 27 of said Hammett Tract, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Southern Railway Main track on Pinckney Street; thence S. 68-50' E. one hundred and twenty-seven (127) feet and two (2) inches, along the north side of Pinckney Street to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28; thence N. 21-10' E. one hundred and ninety (190) feet to an iron pin on a ten foot alley, and corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28; thence along said alley N. 22-50' W. one hundred and seventeen (117) feet and ten (10) inches along the south side of the said ten foot alley to an iron pin in Main Line of Southern Railway track; thence along said Railway track S. 36-10' W. one hundred and ninety-seven (197) feet and ten (10) inches to the beginning corner.

Also, all those certain lots of land in the said Township, County and State, known as Lots Nos. 28 and 29 on said plat of Hammett Tract, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Pinckney Street, corner of Lots 28 and 29; thence N. 21-10' E. one hundred and ninety (190) feet to an iron pin on the South side of a ten foot alley; thence N. 68-50' W. two hundred (200) feet along said alley to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28; thence S. 68-50' E. Two hundred (200) feet to the beginning corner, being the same lots conveyed to W. R. Forrest, deceased by W. S. Purdette by deed dated Feb. 2nd, 1911, and recorded in the R.L.C. Office for the Greenville County in Vol. 36, page 165 and the same conveyed to J. M. Watkins and W. R. Ramsour by deed dated August 25th, 1919 and recorded in the R.L.C. Office in Vol. 54, page 129.
