(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. D. Parrish and J. C. Hower, all that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lot No. 33 of Block "B" of Cagle Park as shown on plat recorded in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book C, page 238, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Tindal Avenue, corner of lot No. 32, and running thence S. 0-53 E. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89-07 W. sixty-one (61) feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 0-53 W. one hundred and fifty feet (150) to an iron pipe on Tindal Avenue at corner of lot No. 34; thence with Tindal Avenue N. 89-07 E. sixty-one (61) feet to the beginning corner.

Subject however to the same conditions and restrictions contained in the deed from J. F. McKelvey to J. C. Harper and recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 69, page 30.

This being one of the same lots conveyed by J. F. McKelvey to J. C. Harper by deed dated Feb. 24th, 1920 and recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 69, page 30; and conveyed to me by J. C. Harper by deed dated August 5th, 1920, and recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Vol. 69, page 95.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the grantee herein assumed the payment of a mortgage on the lot described herein, being for the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), and given by William Goldsmith, W. D. Workman, and Walter W. Goldsmith to the Cagle Park Company, said mortgage being recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 62, page 161, and dated July 1, 1919.

The grantee herein assumes the payment of the above named mortgage with interest from the date of this conveyance, (May 11th, 1921) said mortgage bearing interest at the rate of six (6) percent per annum.
