The above right-of-way is for the privilege of cutting and keeping cut, all trees that will in any way endanger the Southern Power lines, running parallel to Arch McMahan line.

with reference to street, and continuing approximately parallel to said lower line through millage said beyond to the property line of Victor Monaghan Co's property, when said lower line leaves the same.

Together with the right to trim such trees where the top or branches interfere with the overhead line, and lines not to interfere with any present streets or opening of new street near or within ten feet from the line of any house or building, or placed near enough to the house to interfere with anyone occupying same. The above line to be located beginning at Southern Power Co's Substation and running along the south side of street on opposite side of said street from the present town line and similarly located.
