Whereas, on August 14th, 1922, M. A. Smith an individual of the County and State aforesaid, did file his voluntary petition in bankruptcy in the United States District Court for the Western District of South Carolina praying that he be adjudged a bankrupt, and was thereupon and thereafter adjudged; and at a meeting of creditors of said bankrupt held on August 27th, 1922, Wyatt Aiken, Jr. was duly elected and qualified Trustee, and is now engaged in the performance of his duties as such trustee, and

Whereas by order of E. M. Blythe, Esq. Referee in Bankruptcy, dated the 29th day of December, 1922, some of the real estate of the said bankrupt was ordered sold at public auction; and on the 29th day of January, 1923 in pursuance of said order the aforesaid real estate of the bankrupt was sold at public auction at Greenville Court House, South Carolina to Garrison Wyatt for the sum of Four Hundred Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars, he being at that price the highest bidder, which sale was duly confirmed by Hon. H. H. Watkins, District Judge, in an order dated the 14th day of April, 1923.

Smith, Bankrupt in consideration of the premises and the sum of Four hundred fifty (\$450.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Garrison Wyatt (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Garrison Wyatt
