(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said American Bank & Trust Company, as Trustees, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on what is known as Paris Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the center of said Paris Road and running thence with the center of said road N. 70 E. 248 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of another road between this property and Augusta Circle property, S. 71-40 E. 266.3 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said road, S. 70-55 E. 505 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 12-00 W. 768.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 41-20 W. 1217 feet to the beginning corner, containing Ten (10) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of Augusta Circle property and other lands of the grantor, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by P.C. Lupo by his deed dated September 26, 1922; recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 75, Page 408.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on what is known as Paris Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center of Paris Road, corner of above described tract, thence with line of same S. 41-10 E. 1616 feet to an iron pipe on line of land now or formerly of Jenkinson, thence with Jenkinson's line S. 55-43 W. 530 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 41-10 W. 1227.4 feet to iron pipe, corner of a five (5) acre tract conveyed to L.W. Paris by B.E. Geer; thence along the line of same N. 29-0 W. 102.4 feet to an iron pipe, corner of Sarah R. West's property; thence with West's line N. 61-0 E. 130 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing with West's line N. 29-50 W. 577 feet to center of Paris Road; thence with center of Paris Road N. 69-50 E. 319 feet to the point of beginning, less however, lot heretofore conveyed by L.W. Paris to C.D. West (deed not yet recorded) described as follows: Beginning at iron pin on the east side of Paris Road, 200 feet from the beginning corner in the above described lot; thence S. 75-39 E. 256.3 feet to iron pin; thence N. 56-47 E. 126.7 feet to iron pin; thence N. 41-10 W. 233.7 feet to pipe on East side of Paris Road; thence along the East side of said Road, S. 69-50 E. 108.2 feet to the beginning corner. The above described tract is composed of 17.3 acres of a larger tract conveyed to me by L.W. Paris by deed dated June 6, 1922, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 89, page 55, and also a lot on the South side of Paris Road conveyed to me by L.W. Paris, by deed dated December 5, 1922, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 87, page 85. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said American Bank & Trust Company, as Trustee, its successors and assigns forever, upon the following trust, to-wit: To hold said lands and to sell and convey the same as a whole or in parcels as may be deemed advisable, for cash, or partly for cash and part on credit, and after paying all expenses incurred in the execution of this trust, including taxes, to pay over the balance of the proceeds of said sale to me, the said B.E.
