Hooper's Creek being part of the lands conveyed to Sarah
E. Farr and J. P. Shackley and the interest of the said
J. P. Shackley being conveyed to Sarah E. Farr by deed

reside.

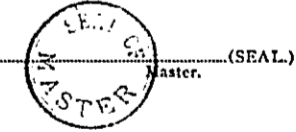
TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident
