Whereas, I, Paul Cooley of the county and state aforesaid, am desirous of committing the care, maintenance, education and support of my four children, hereinafter named, unto their Grandfather, Casper J. Woodson, of the county and state aforesaid, all of said children being infants and their mothers being dead; and whereas, the said Casper J. Woodson agrees to accept the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of the said four children during their minority, and further agrees that he will hold and manage all property of said children and the increase thereof for their own separate use until they shall have arrived at the age of twenty-one years, or shall have married; now therefore:

I know all men by these presents: That I, the said Paul Cooley, for and in consideration of the premises herein stated and the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Casper J. Woodson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of my children, Angus Cooley, aged five, Eunice Cooley, aged three, J. C. Cooley aged two and James H. Cooley aged three months, to the said Casper J. Woodson for and during the minority of said children.

It is further agreed and made a part of the consideration hereof that should the said Casper J. Woodson die before said children, or any of them, shall have become of full age, then and in that event, it is understood that Nannie E. Woodson, wife of the said Casper J. Woodson and Grandmother of said children shall immediately have full control of said minor children under the same conditions as herein stated. It is further understood that upon the death of both Casper J. Woodson and Nannie E. Woodson, the said Paul Cooley shall immediately come into control of said minor children, and this deed shall in that event be null and void.

Together with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by me, as parent, over and in respect to the said Angus Cooley, Eunice Cooley, J. C. Cooley and James H. Cooley.

To have and to hold, the said Angus Cooley, Eunice Cooley, J. C. Cooley and James H. Cooley against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right or privilege through me in and to the said Angus Cooley, Eunice Cooley, J. C. Cooley and James H. Cooley
