Tratt and Marie Tratt agree to accept the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of the said Sarah Andrew, during her minority and further agree that they will, by proper devise and bequest make her equal with their own children in the distribution of their estate, and that they will further hold and manage all of the property of the said Sarah Andrew and the income thereof for her separate use until she shall have married or arrived at the age of twenty one years.

Now therefore know all men by these presents that Annie Pearl Andrew for and in consideration of the premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of my child Sarah Andrew born on the 10th day of July, A.D. 1921, to Luther H. & Marie Tratt for and during her minority.

Together with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by them as parents over and in respect to the said Sarah Andrew.

To have and to hold, the said Sarah Andrew against myself and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest right or privilege, through me, in and to the said Sarah Andrew.
