"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina and described as follows: Beginning at an alley on Forrest Street and running thence N. 48-40° W 71.6 to an iron pin; thence S. 85-40° W. 44 to an iron pin on a street, thence with said street S. 6-20° W. 106 to an iron pin on said street; thence S. 48-15 E. 33.6 to an iron pin; thence N. 54-35 E. 30.2 to an iron pin on alley, thence N. 49-40 E. 13.1 to an iron pin on an Alley; thence with said Alley N. 43 E. 75.1 to the beginning corner. It is understood that this alley shall be open for the benefit of the parties hereto during the life of this agreement, if not for a longer period".

(10) To the faithful performance of the conditions herein set forth the parties hereto bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
