Whereas by an act of the General Assembly of South Carolina,
approved February 2, 1923 (33 State. 688), Greenville County Library
was dissolved; &c. it

Resolved by the trustees of Greenville County Library, heretofore
appointed by the Governor of South Carolina, at a meeting
held on the nineteenth day of December, 1923, that neither
said Greenville County Library, nor any of said trustees
have any further interest in or claim upon the lot
of land situate in the City and County of Greenville and
State of South Carolina, on which the old Court House or Re-
cord Building stands, or in any land adjacent thereto
or in said building.

Resolved further that S. E. Bradshaw, as chairman, and
L. O. Patterson, as secretary of said board, he and they are
hereby authorized on behalf of said Greenville County Library
and said trustees to execute a quit claim deed conveying
all interest (if any) at any time held by said Greenville
County Library in said premises to Greenville Chamber of
Commerce until the thirty-first of March, 2023, and to
Greenville County after the last mentioned date.

We the undersigned members of the board of trustees of
Greenville County Library, heretofore appointed by the Governor
of South Carolina, do hereby certify that the foregoing is a
full, true and correct copy of the resolution unanimous-
ly adopted at a meeting of said board of trustees
held at the office of L. O. Patterson in the Palmetto Build-
ing on the nineteenth day of December, A.D. 1923, of
which meeting we had due notice; and that a
majority of said board was present at said meeting.
