J.W. Kirkpatrick's Lassee

This indenture, made the 21 day of June, 1924.

Witnesseth, that I, H. H. Simon, do hereby lease unto J. W. Kirkpatrick, all that piece parcel by lot of land ~~marked~~ <sup>described</sup>, lying and being in the County - and State of ~~Marked~~ <sup>South Carolina</sup> in the City of Greenville at the corner of ~~Richardson~~ <sup>Henderson</sup> and College Streets fronting on said ~~blocks~~ <sup>blocks</sup>. Being approximately fifty feet and running back ~~the~~ <sup>from</sup> the parallel lines approximately 100 feet, being the same lot as designated as lot no 4 on a plat of R. E. Taylor ~~dated~~ <sup>drawn</sup> January 1931 with corrections made thereto.

To have and hold for the term of three years, beginning the  
1st day of July, 1841, and I the lessor above named  
promised to pay for the rent of said premises the sum  
of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) Dolars per month for the  
first year and one thousand seven hundred (\$1,750.00) Dolars per  
month (from the second to said third year), said sum to be paid  
monthly in advance on the first of each and every month  
and to quit and deliver up the premises to the lessor  
or his attorney peaceable and quietly at the end of the term  
together with any buildings or improvements erected thereon  
by me, said lessor to have no improvements to go to the lessor  
as his property stored.

It is also agreed that if there is default in the payment of the rent above stipulated, for as much as sixty days after the same is due, the said H. H. Simon, his attorney or agent shall have the right to re-enter and re-possess such premises at his option and to expel and remove therefrom the said J. W. Kirkpatrick or any other person occupying the same.

In case of the breach of any conditions of this agreement, at any time, the improvements situate thereon are to revert to H. St. Simon, together with the premises.
