5. It is understood that should the Purchaser fail to carry out the agreement as to the payments herein provided, this contract shall become void at the option of the seller, and all payments already made shall apply as rent.
6. The Purchaser shall have the right to improve said premises as he may see fit, provided same are at his own expense.
7. The purchaser is to return said lot for taxation and is to pay all taxes thereon.
