

Renunciation of Dower.
State of South Carolina
County of Greenville.

Whereas in a certain deed of conveyance executed by W. P. Conyers to P. S. Boutler on Jan. 7, 1911, recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, the Dower appears to have been renounced by M. G. Conyers on Jan. 6, 1911, (See Vol. 9, page 396, R. M. C. office)

And whereas said renunciation of Dower being dated prior to signing of deed of conveyance and for that reason being inadequate to convey the dower right of the said M. G. Conyers to the grantee named in said deed,

And whereas the parcel and tract of land is described in said deed as follows, to-wit: All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated in said County and State containing sixty-three acres, more or less, adjoining lands of S. J. Pace and Jno. Hagood, about five (5) miles from Marietta in the State aforesaid, being same land conveyed to me (W. P. Conyers) by James Williams,

Now, I, A. G. Gower, a Notary Public for South Carolina do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern that Mrs. M. G. Conyers, the wife of the above named W. P. Conyers did this day appear before me, and upon being privately and separately examined by me, did declare that she does freely, voluntarily and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release and forever relinquish unto Hunter-Wilson Lumber Company, a corporation under the laws of South Carolina, its successors and assigns, all her interest and estate, and also all her right and claim of Dower of, in and to all and singular the premises described hereinabove and in said deed mentioned and released.
