 Received of Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Co., Incorporated Five + 200/100 Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own or in which I have an interest, in the 1/4 of 1/4 County of Greenville and State of S. C. and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property; said sum is received in full payment for said right and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other Company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 18 inches, said sum being received in full payment therefor.

The telephone Company agrees to relocate its poles and cables, on said property, to accommodate future construction of buildings.
