(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*J. W. James*, all that certain piece, parcels or lot of land situate  
in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West  
side of Eno River; beginning at a stone on the bank of  
Eno River, thence S. 17 W. 2.70 chains to a popular, thence  
S. 27 W. 2.66 to a birch, thence S. 42 W. 2.12 to a stone,  
thence S. 89 W. 1.75 to a hickory, thence S. 63 W. 2.70 to a  
stone, thence S. 0.87 W. 2.15 to a stone, thence S. 1 E. 1.50 to a  
stone, thence S. 24 E. 4.80 to a stone on Sennett's line, thence  
along the Sennett's line N. 61 E. 54.50 to a stone on bank  
of Eno River, thence up the Eno River to the beginning  
being the corner tract of land conveyed to me by Pinney B.  
Baird by his deed dated Dec. 9, 1922 and recorded in
