(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. B. M. Grant, her heirs and assigns. All of that
lot of land with the buildings thereon situate on the
corner of Cross and Bailey Streets: Beginning at
an iron pin on the corner of said streets and
running thence with Bailey Street N. 30 E. 31.25 feet
to a stake, corner lot no. 2 on Bailey Street;
thence along the joint line of lots 1 and 2, N. 54.15
W. 100 feet to a stake, corner lots 1 and 2, thence
S. 30 W. 31.25 feet to an iron pin on Cross Street;
thence along Cross Street E. 54.15 E. 100 feet to the
beginning corner being designated as lot no. 1 on
plat made by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor.

Also, that lot situate on Bailey Street, adjoin-
ing the above: Beginning at an iron pin, corner
lots no. 1 and the north line of Bailey Street,
and runs thence with the north line of said
Street 31.25 feet to an iron pin in the corner
of lot no. 3, in the north line of said Street
thence with the joint line of lots 2 and 3 N.
54.15 W. 100 feet to a stake, corner of lots 3;
thence S. 30 W. 31.25 feet to an iron pin in the corner of
lot 1; thence with the joint line of lots 1 and 2
E. 54.15 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner on
Bailey Street, known as lot no. 2.

Also, that other lot situate on Bailey Street
County and State aforesaid, having a frontage
of 62 1/2 feet and a depth of 100 feet and known
and designated as lots nos. 3 and 4 on plat of
Dalton. All of the above lots being the same as
