(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

T. G. Jones, his heirs and assigns; All that certain tract of land in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, consisting on the south side of Blazingard street, (near the Augusta road) and being further and described as lots 160 &amp; 161 according to a plat of Survey of said town b. &amp; G. Engle &amp; M. D. Jones, dated May 22, 1922, and recorded in Plat book "B" at page 141 Recd Drawing the following section and boundaries thereto;

Beginning at an iron pair on the south side of Blazingard street joint corner of lot No. 3 and 4 and running thence with line of lot No. 3 S. 26-30 E. 199.6 feet to a point in line of property of J. R. Davenport estate, thence with Davenport line S. 163-37 W. 60 feet, joint corner of lot No. 3 and 5 thence with line of lot No. 5 S. 26-30 W. 199.6 feet to an iron pair on Blazingard street, thence with Blazingard street N. 63-30 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

As in part of the consideration herein above expressed the grantee recite thy accepting this deed expressly reserving and promising to pay in certain note in the sum of one hundred Dollars (\$100) secured by a certificate over the above described lot executed by the grantee to the Farmers Loan and Trust Company, dated May 28th, 1924 together with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum, payable semi-annually until paid. Said note for the year 1924 to be prorated as of May 28th, 1924.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said T. G. Jones, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said T. G. Jones, his

heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
