Ballentine, prepared by R.L. Dalton, C.E., in August 1924, which plan is recorded in the P.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 1, page 150, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Mayne Street at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Mayne Street and a twenty foot unnamed street as shown on said Plat and running thence with Mayne Street as the line N. 31-02 E. 43 feet to a stake, joint corner of lots one and two; thence with the joint line of said lots N. 9-45 W. 100 feet to a stake on line of lot No. 1; thence with the line of said lot S. 31-02 W. 43 feet to a stake on the East side of said twenty foot unnamed street; thence with the East line of said Street S. 9-45 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner. This is a part of the property purchased by me from J.C. Wilford by deed dated May 1st, 1924, and recorded in the P.M.C. Office for Greenville County in deed book Vol. 120, page 124.
