Williams and his Heirs and assigns; all 14.1 certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina and county of Greenville in O'Neal Township, about six miles from Greer, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat thereof made by John M. Curtoe dated March, 17, 1906, to-wit, beginning at a post on the south-west side of the Jordan Road, being the east corner of the tract this day surveyed by me to G. B. Sloan, and running thence along the Sloan line S. 48° W. 38.94 chains to a stake; thence S. 60° 28' E. 7.07 chains to a stone 3x4m on the west corner of tract No. 4; thence N. 43° 44' E. 36.30 chains along the line of tract No. 4 to a stake on the Jordan Road; thence along said road in a general north-westerly direction (perhaps approximately N. 53° 28' W.) 4.00 chains to the beginning corner, containing twenty and one-half acres, more or less; this being the southeast part of tract No. 3 as shown on said plat, and being a portion of a large tract supposed to contain about 1470 acres devised by the will of Wardry McBee, deceased, to his grandchildren the four children of W. P. McBee released and partitioned among them by mutual deeds.
