in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
one thousand five hundred DOLLARS,
and other valuable considerations
to Walter R. Bryson in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Walter R. Bryson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Walter R. Bryson:
The two certain lots or parcels of land
situate, lying and being in Greenville
Township, County and State aforesaid, on the
South side of Mountain Vista Avenue in Traylor
Park, and being known and designated as lots
No. 183 and 184 in said subdivision as shown
on a plat made by R. C. Dalton March 1923
which plat is duly recorded in the office
of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plot Book "F"
page 114, and having according to said plat
the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of
Mountain Vista Avenue, corner of lots 182 and 183
and running thence with the joint line of said
lots 182-338-225 feet to stake corner of lot No.
217; thence N. 64-37 E. 140 feet along the rear line
of lot No. 217 and 216 to stake corner of lot No.
215; thence with line of that lot N. 25-13 W.
225 feet to stake on Mountain Vista Avenue;
thence with said Avenue S. 64-37 W. 140 feet to
point of beginning.

Notwithstanding upon the following restrictions
conditions which are expressed for the benefit
of all persons owning lots in said subdivision

- (1) This property nor any part thereof shall ever
be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any
person having any percentage of negro blood.
- (2) No liquor or faro or spirit shall ever be sold
on said premises.
- (3) The property shall be used only for residential
purposes and no use shall be made thereof
which would constitute a nuisance or
injure the value of the neighboring lots.
- (4) No dwelling house costing less than
\$500.00 shall be erected on said property, nor
shall any building be erected nearer to
Mountain Vista Avenue than sixty feet.
- (5) The grantor reserves the right to lay and
place or to authorize the laying and placing
of street car tracks, sewer, gutters, paving
and pipes, the erection of telephone, telegraph and
electric light poles, or the placing of any other public
utility in or along any of the roadway without
 liability to compensate any lot owner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
pertaining,
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said
Walter R. Bryson, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I, Haynesworth, do hereby bind
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said
Walter R. Bryson, his

heirs and assigns, against
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
