Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, did convey Form I. title to real estate, certain lands to me, of which, the lots conveyed by this deed herein are a part, with power to me to convey said land as a whole or in parts, THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

Now, therefore,

ONCE AND FOR EVER BY THESE PRESENTS THE I, H.W. Townes, as Trustee of Greenville County
South Carolina

in the sum of Eight Hundred and One (\$800.00)
DOLLARS,

to me, *Pernellie Jeanneette Haynie*, in hand paid
and delivered being a new instrument.

Perpetually binding upon me, my heirs and assigns, forever: All those two lots of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being lots Nos. Twenty-three (23) and twenty-four (24) of Hillside Terrace a sub-division of land represented by a plat recorded in Plat Book #7, page 154, P.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Said lots having the following notes and bounds. Beginning on west side of Smith Street at corner of Lot No. 23; thence W. 54-21 E. 140 feet to the corner of Lot No. 23; thence N. 54-21 W. 140.4 feet to corner of Lot No. 49; thence S. 54-47 W. 140 feet to corner of Lot No. 25; thence S. 54-21 E. 125.1 feet to the beginning corner, and being a part of the land conveyed to Minnie Hunt by J.B. Earle, deed dated May 15th, 1923, and recorded in Volume 37, page 15, P.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Subject, however, to the following restrictions:
No house to be erected for less than twenty-five hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars, on any one lot.
Distance of porch to dwelling or dwellings erected on lots conveyed from sidewalk on street to be seventeen (17) feet.
No mercantile building, cold storage, public garage or public building other than office, school or church building to be erected on premises conveyed.
The said premises shall not for a period of ninety-nine (99) years from date hereof be occupied, rented, leased or any manner used by Greeks or colored persons, or sold to Greeks or colored person or persons other than for investment, and investment applies to Greeks only, except that the servants house for each residence erected on the premises herein described may be occupied by one colored person or persons as the owner of said premises may desire. The conditions and restrictions herein imposed shall attach to and run with the premises herein conveyed and be binding upon the grantees and subsequent owners thereof and a breach of any of said conditions or restrictions shall cause said premises to revert to the grantor herein.

Office for Greenville County.
