Deed of conveyance made and delivered by the Plaintiff, John S. Elliott, and defendant, and as he is entitled to do, for the sum of One Thousand Dollars, and defense into the said
J. S. Elliott and his heirs and assigns, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land
described, lying and being in the town of Greenville, in Greenville County and
bounded, a short distance north of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being
known and designated as the east half of lot No. ten (10) in Block "B" of Oakland Heights,
as shown on T. C. Nease's plat thereof, dated June 1, 1911, and recorded in the office of
the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State, in Plat Book
"B", in page 204, and having, according to said plat, the following rates and bounds
beginning at a stake in the center of the front or north boundary line of lot
No. ten, on the south side of Mountainview Avenue 300 feet westward from the S.W. corner
of Mountainview Avenue and Townes Street, and running thence S. 9° 45' E. (parallel with
Townes Street) 175± ft. through the center of block No. ten to a stake on a limestone
creek Alley, thence along said Alley S. 20° 15' E. (parallel with Mountainview Avenue), 50
feet to a stake in the S.W. corner of lot No. eleven (11), on said plat; thence N. 9° 45'
E. 175± feet along the line of lot No. eleven to a stake in Mountainview Avenue; thence
along said Avenue N. 20° 15' W. 50 feet to the beginning; corner, this being the same lot
described in the said A. S. Potter by S. S. Daughler, by deed dated October 1, 1921,
and recorded in said office, on Oct. 4, 1921, in deed book 73, at page 220.
There is no other lien or encumbrance on said property, by mortgage, judgment or otherwise,
except a mortgage for twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500.00) to American Building and
