(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Julian Calhoun

All that lot or parcel of land lying between present Appalachian Highway between Tryon and Landrum and the old road no longer used that paralleled the highway just to the south of it. Beginning at a stake on the northern edge of said road McCleve's corner and running in a northerly direction with McCleve's line about forty-five feet to the edge of the highway, thence in an easterly direction with highway about seven hundred feet until the highway and old road intersect, thence in a westerly direction along the old road about seven hundred feet to the beginning corner.

The intent of this agreement is to convey all of my right title and interest on the southern side of the Appalachian Highway.

The above described portion of land sold to me by James St. Fair by deed dated 3rd day of March 1911 and recorded R. M. C. Greenville County Book 13, page 281.
