the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Joseph Gosnell All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in the Belair Township on the North side of the Jordan road, and having the following notes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron gib on the Jordan road and running thence N. 60° E. 19.00 chs. to a stone, thence N. 66 W. 6.95 chs. to a stone, thence N. 19 E. 11.17 chs. to a stone, thence S. 84-15 E. 6.95 chs. to a stake, thence N. 25 W. 13.30 chs. to a stone, thence S. W. 8.55 chs. to a Sweet Gum tree, thence S. 84 W. 1.64 chs. to a Sweet Gum, thence S. 79 W. 8.50 chs. to a Wild Cherry tree, thence down the meanderings of branch to a stake, thence S. 6-45' E. 22.00 chs. to a Chestnut tree, thence S. 65-15' E. 12.89 chs. to a stone, thence S. 25 W. 17.80 chs. to a Pine tree on the Jordan road, thence down the said Jordan road to the beginning corner containing sixty seven and 78/100 (67 7/100) acres, more or less according to a plat of the J.C.
