Rickenbaker, Grace Rickenbaker and Annie Rickenbaker Yancy, their heirs and assigns, forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just out side the limits of the city of Greenville, on the North side of Prentiss Avenue and Simmon and designated as Lot No. 10, Block "Z" of the O. P. Miller property as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book "C", Page 176, as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on Prentiss Avenue, corner of Lot No. 12 and running thence with Prentiss Avenue, N. 45-27 E. Sixty-five (65) feet to corner of Lot No. 8, thence with a line of Lot No. 8, N. 44-33 W. One hundred Eighty (180) feet to an alley sixteen feet wide, thence with a line of said alley S. 45-27 W.
