C. H. Bellingsley. In the lower part road (or West Highway) and in the Northwestern section of the Town of Marietta and in Beaverdam Branch, waters of North Saluda River, adjoining lands now or formerly of Mrs. Lizzie C. Cleveland, Pritchett and fronting on said Jones Gap Road containing 10 acres more or less on which land there is situated in eight room dwelling barn and store-house. This being the same land conveyed to me by Artie Jane Forrest by deed dated August 11th. 1925 recorded in Vol. 88 page 374, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, it being the intention of this deed to convey all lands included in above deed to me.

As part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantor assumed and agrees to pay a balance of eight hundred (\$800) dollars due on note and mortgage executed by the grantor in favor of B. S. Tilman, together with accrued interest thereon from August 11, 1925. This mortgage covers the above described property and was originally in amount of \$900.
