the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

E. P. Hudson, and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the east side of Pettigrew Street, in the City of Greenville, S. C. and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Pettigrew Street and running thence with Pettigrew Street N. 76-45 E. 55 feet, nine inches, to an iron pin, thence S. 15-00 E. 196 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76-45 W. 55 feet and 9 inches to an iron pin; thence with dividing line of lots Nos. 4 and 5, N. 15-00 W. 196 feet to the beginning corner, and being known as Lot No. 5 on plat recorded in Plat Book C, Page 30.
