Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Seventy Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$79,750.00) Dollars,
to me paid by the said C. D. Wilson

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

C. D. Wilson, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All those certain lots of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Simpsonville, County aforesaid State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 31, as shown by subdivision and plat of the estate of S. J. Wilson, deceased, made by W. J. Middle Surveyor in August, 1924, which plat is of record in the Register's office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "B" at page 271. Reference is hereby made to said plat for a description of the various lots herein contained by metes and bounds and courses and distances. The said lots were in part of the land owned by S. J. Wilson at the time of his death.


