the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

The Norwood National Bank a corporation, its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate.

All that certain tract of land in the County and State aforesaid, about 13 1/2 miles South of the City of Greenville on the Greenville Woodruff Road, known and designated upon a plat of the U. S. Military lands as Lot No. 5 and more specifically described as follows:
