the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

John A. Russell and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All those three certain lots of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on Spartanburg Road in East Overbrook, each having a frontage on Spartanburg Road of 61 1/2 feet, and each running a depth 200 feet to a 20 foot alley, each lot being 60 feet wide at rear, being the same land conveyed to W. A. Wallace September 14, 1925, by deed recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 91, page 177. The above property is hereby conveyed subject to the lien of a certain mortgage executed by Fred H. Plesio to the Greenville Real Estate Loan & Investment Company, which mortgage is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Vol. 91 at page 170.
