as Judge of the Court of Probate as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of \$18,000.00

paid me by the said Greenville News Company, a Corporation Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville News Company, a Corporation

and its successors et cetera all and assigns forever, all that tract of land situate in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the West side of Laurens Street, Beginning at an iron pin 172 feet from the corner of McBee Avenue and Laurens Street, and running thence in a northerly direction with Laurens Street thirty (30) feet to an iron pin on T.C. Gower's corner (livery stable and hall); thence with line of said Gower in a westerly direction one hundred (100) feet; thence running from Gower's line in a southerly - parallel with Laurens Street thirty (30) feet to an iron pin in line of lot of L.P. Hillhouse, and thence one hundred (100) feet in an Easterly direction to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to W.B.
