the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mary R. Mock* and *her* heirs and assigns forever,

an undivided one-third interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in that one of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stake 3x at the corner of lot no 2 on the south side of Naughton Avenue (formerly Highland Avenue) and running thence west on said Avenue 76 3/4 ft 58 feet to a stake corner of lot no 4, thence 55 1/4 ft 22 3/4 feet to the back line at a stake 3x; thence south 34 1/4 ft 58 feet to a stake 3x corner of lot no 2; thence N. 55 3/4 E. 23 3/4 feet to Highland (Naughton) Avenue, the beginning corner and containing 129 3/4 square feet, more or less, and being more fully described by deed dated July 10, 1899, recorded in P.
