seven (27) acres, more or less, and bounded lands  
of *J. P. Gallinger*, *J. L. Jones*, *Mrs. Beach* and  
*B. G. Butler*, and *J. D. Smith*.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging, or in anywise appertaining,  
and the reversions and the remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand  
whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said *Mary St. Loox, deceased*.

and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them.

Heirs and Assigns forever.


