Know all men by these Presents, that The Salvation Army, a religious and charitable corporation incorporated under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, having its principal office at 122 West 14th Street, New York City, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollars, and other valuable considerations to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by The Salvation Army, a religious and charitable corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Georgia having its principal office in the City of Atlanta in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said The Salvation Army, the Grantee herein,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the limits of the City of Greenville, west of Rutherford Street, known as Lot no. 13 on plat of property of The Salvation Army made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 247 and having the following courses and distances:-

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Fair Street, corner of lot no. 12 (which stake is 146 feet from the intersection of Rutherford Road and Fair Street) and running thence with Fair Street South 89-34 West 57.5 feet to stake, corner of Lot no. 14, thence with line of Lot no. 14 South 0-30 West 135.5 feet to stake, joint corner of Lots no. 13, 14, 15 and 16; thence with line of Lot no. 16 North 81-20 East 58.25 feet to a stake, joint corner Lots 12, 13, 16 and 17; and thence with line of lot no. 12 North 0-30 East 127.2 feet to the beginning corner on Fair Street.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said The Salvation Army, the grantee herein, its successors

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and assigns forever.

This conveyance is made pursuant to an Order of the Supreme Court held in and for the County of New York, bearing date the 23rd day of May, 1927, in a proceeding therein entitled "In The Matter of The Application of The Salvation Army for Leave to Convey its Real Property Located in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina".

And the said The Salvation Army, the grantee herein, its successors and assigns does hereby bind itself and its successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said The Salvation Army, the grantee herein, its successors and assigns, against itself and its successors and assigns lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
