Whereas, Under date of September 5, 1922, Manufacturers Warehouse Company, executed to Farmers Lean & Trust Company its certain mertgage in the amount of \$30,000.00 which mertgage is recorded in Mertgage Book 42, page 430, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and cavers a certain let of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, bounded on the north by a right of way owned by Southern Railway Company, on the east by South Laurens Street (formerly Jackson Street), on the south by lands now or formerly of the Estate of J. M. McGoo, and on the west by River Street; and

Whereas, On the same day, to wit, September 5, 1922, Manufacturers Warehouse Company executed to Farmers Lean & Trust Company a second mortgage in the amount of \$46,300,00, which mortgage is recorded in Mertgage Book 28, page 368, said R. M. C. Office and covers the same lot of land covered by the said first mertgage; and

Whereas, Under date of January 30, 1929, Manufacturers Warehouse Company executed unto National Biscuit Company a lease of the eastern portion of the property described in the two above mentioned mertgages, which lease is recorded in Deed Book 147, page 338, said R. M. C. Office, and runs for a term of ten (10) years, beginning May 1, 1929, and in said lease it is provided as follows:

"Lesser agrees, previded Lessee's business grews to such an extent that it cannot preperly stere its merchandise in the storereem of above described building, to turn ever to Lessee 1,000 sq ft. of floor space on the second floor of its warehouse adjoining Lessee's premises on the west, it being under stood that said space shall directly adjoin Lessee's storereem on the west, and it being further understood that lesser will separate said 1000 sq. ft. of floor space from its own premises by a substantial weeden or tile partition extending from floor to roof. Lessor further agrees to connect said 1000 sq. ft. of floor space with Lessee's stockroom by an archway properly finished off and approximately 8 ft. wide and 8 ft. high; " and

Whereas, under date of March 6, 1930, Manufacturers Warehouse Company, by its deed recorded in Deed Book 121, page 196, said R. M. C. Office, conveyed the entire preperty covered in the two mortgages above mentioned to Farmers Lean & Trust Company, but said conveyance did not operate to effect a merger of the mortgages above mentioned for the reason that they had previously been sold and transferred to other parties who new ewn same; and

Whereas, Farmers Loan and Trust Company desires to refinance the mertgage indebtedness now existing against the property described in the above mentioned mertgages but is unable to do so without the trouble, expense and delay of a fercolesure sale on account of the clause in the lease from Manufacturers Warehouse Company to national Biscuit Company hereinabove set out; and

Whereas, National Biscuit Company is desireus of accommodating Farmers Lean & Trust Company, in the premises:

New, therefore, know all men by these presents, that in consideration of the premises and the sum of one dollar by Farmers Lean & Trust Company, a corporation organised and existing under the laws of South Carelina, paid to National Biscuit Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of New Jersey (the receipt whereof is hereby acknewledged), said National Biscuit Company does hereby release its rights under the above queted clause of its lease to the extent of permitting Farmers Lean & Trust Sempany to execute a first mertgage on the western pertion of the property described in the mertgages hereinabeve referred to, which new mertgage shall be in the amount of \$12,600.00 and to execute amouther mertgage covering the entire property hereinabove described in the amount of \$18,000.00 and to execute a third mortgage esvering the entire praperty hereinabove described in the amount of \$21,000.00; it being understood that the two eld mertgages hereinabeve described in the aggregate amount of \$75,880.80 are to be satisfied en the record at the time of the delivery of the three new mertgages hereinabeve mentioned aggregating \$51,000.00, the entire scepe and purpose of this release being to see that the mertgages under the new mortgages obtain title to the mortgaged premises unaffected by the elause of National Bissuit Company's lease above queted. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to release or impair the right of National Bisquit Company as temant. as against the landlerd, to demand the said additional space as provided in said elause.

Page 2.

In the event that the rights of the tenant under the said clause are fercelesed, then the tenant shall have the eptien to terminate the said lease on thirty days' notice in writing, should it require additional space. This release shall enure to the benefit of Liberty Life Insurance Commany, J. B. Ricketts, Trustee and Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, or any other persons or corporations whose names may be inserted in the contemplated new mortgages and this release shall operate for the protection of all interest and other sums of mency in addition to the principal sums which may become due under the terms of said new mortgages.
