all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
Being lot no. 60 according to survey and plat by J. D. Olin
dated September 17, 1913 and recorded in R. R. C.
Office for Greenville County. Beginning at an iron
pin on the south side of Oakbrook Road and
running thence N. 85-20 E. 59 feet along south side
of Oakbrook Road to an iron pin in the front corner
of lot #60 and 59; thence S. 5-53 E. 181-4 feet along the
faint line of lot 60 and 59 to an iron pin in thence S.
59-35 N. 12-8 feet to an iron pin on East side of
Oakbrook Circle; thence along east side of Oakbrook
Circle N. 16-24 E. 35-6 feet; thence N. 11-32 E. 34-6 feet;
