In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,  
unto the said Annie Randolph Hale for and during the full term  
of her natural life and upon her death with remainder  
to the said Tildal Hale and her heirs <sup>and assigns forever</sup>  
all that piece or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina  
subject to the life estate hereinafter reserved.  
All that certain lot of land or parcel of land situate  
lying and being in the State of South Carolina  
and County of Greenville in the first ward of  
the City of Greenville; Beginning at a Stake  
on the back side of Stone Avenue and  
running S 42° W two hundred twenty-eight and  
one half (228 1/2) feet to a Stake thence S 87° E  
two hundred eight (208) feet or more to a  
Stake, thence N 42° E two hundred twenty-six  
(226) feet to a Stake on Stone Avenue, thence along  
Stone Avenue two hundred eight (208) feet to the  
beginning corner.

above reserved to myself myself and my  
heirs and assigns, against myself and my  
heirs, and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
