located in the town of West Greenville on the electric car line and near Beckett Road and on what is known as Woodside Avenue and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Woodside Avenue corner of property formerly owned by W. A. Bates and running thence with Woodside Avenue N. 17-44 W. 10.65 feet to pipe thence S. 73-45 W. 4.6 feet to pin on Bates line thence with his line N. 86-23 E. 47.45 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. A. Phillips by his deed dated September 2nd 1920, recorded in Deed Book 71 page 130, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
