in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said G. F. Mathis, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville,

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Near the Laurens Road and East of the City of Greenville, situated as part of lots 12 and 13 of the subdivision of Eastover as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book 3, page 52 having the following lines and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stake on Beechwood Avenue, in line of lot no. 13 and thence 32 feet Northwest of corner of lots 12 and 13 and running thence with Beechwood Avenue and with lines of lots 12 and 13, 755 3/8 feet to a stake corner of lots 11 and 12; thence with line of lots 11 and 12, 32-22 at 141 1/4 feet to a stake; thence N. 57° 27' W. with rear line of lot no. 12, 65 feet to a stake; thence in a straight line approximately 53 feet to the beginning. The boundary includes all of lot no. 12, except a small triangular piece with base of 78 feet in rear line of lot no. 12 and adjoining lot no. 13, and said boundary also includes a small triangle which is part of lot no. 13, adjoining lot no. 12 and with a base of 3 feet on Beechwood Avenue.

The conveyance is made subject to the conditions and restrictions which are hereby declared conditions subsequent, that said property shall be used only for residential purposes, that no building shall be erected thereon casting less than 50% or more than 25 feet from the inside line of the sidewalk, and that said property shall not be sold or leased to otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Lebrae M. Mcgee on the 15th day of March 1922, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County, in Book 512, Page 512.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said G. F. Mathis, his

heirs and assigns forever,

AND do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to

warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said G. F. Mathis, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
