in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,

unto the said Julia D. Charles
Grant Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
about $\frac{3}{4}$ miles from Greenville Court House, between the Perkins Mill Road and the Augusta Road, having the following acres and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin 3xox and running thence S. 14 E. 15.50 chains to an iron pin by a large pine; thence S. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 9.35 to a stone 3xox; thence N. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 15.84 to a stone 3xox; thence N. 65 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 13.83 to the beginning, containing 17.95 acres, more or less, excepting however, from the above described tract a certain tract heretofore conveyed by D.L. Stewart to W.A. Chandler on Sept. 5, 1924, deed recorded in Vol. 77, page 130, office of R.I.C. for said County, containing one and 24/100 acres.

Also that other lot of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, containing one and 68/100 acres, more or less, more fully described in the deed from W.A. Chandler to D.L. Stewart, dated Sept. 5, 1924, recorded in said R.I.C. office in Vol. 97, page 141.

Reference to all of said deeds herein above mentioned is hereby saved for a more particular description.

The tract hereby conveyed contains 18.39 acres, more or less, and embraces all the land conveyed to the grantor by D.L. Stewart by his deed dated Feb. 2, 1928, recorded in Book 118, page 254.

Upon the following trusts:

1. To sell and convey all of the above described tract of land, or any part thereof, and make good fee simple deeds of conveyances for same; and to mortgage all or any part of it.

2. To pay all taxes and expenses of handling said tract.

3. Out of the proceeds of sale of said property to pay off the mortgage debt of six thousand dollars, with interest that may be then due, which debt now exists against the property.

4. To pay the balance of the proceeds of sale remaining after paying taxes, expenses or handling, mortgage debt and interest, to the following persons in the proportions named:

a. To C.F. Putman, his heirs, administrators, executors or assigns, three-eighths of said remainder.

b. To W.A. Chandler, his heirs, administrators, executors or assigns, thirteen-thirty-second of said remainder.

c. To H.B. Tindel, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, one-eighths of said remainder.

d. To Julia D. Charles, her heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, three-thirty-seconds of said remainder.

This conveyance is made subject to the mortgage of C.F. Putman to Julia D. Charles for six thousand dollars, payment of which is assumed by the said C.F. Putman, W.A. Chandler, H.B. Tindel and Julia D. Charles.
