At Gantt Station, known as lot no. 4 on plat of property of Greenville Realty and Investments Company made by R. E. Ballou, Engr., December 1923, containing 1.43 acres, more or less, and having the following corners and distances: Beginning at a stake on the east side of the National Highway, corner of lot no. 3 (which stake is 485.8 feet south of the corner of property of W. L. Breton) and running thence with line of lot no. 3 N. 79-37 E. 421.2 feet to stake in line of lot no. 6; thence with line of said lot S. 2-15 W. 207.2 feet to stake, corner of lot no. 5; thence with line of said lot S. 23-44 W. 379 feet to stake on National Highway; thence with National Highway S. 9-28 W. 115 feet to the beginning, being the same lot conveyed to R.
