all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of East Avenue (formerly known as Main Street) in the city of Greenville, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning in the center of a stone curb at a point on the north side of said street 139.3 feet from the intersection of East Avenue and Main Street, and running thence along said Avenue 74.816 ft. to a wood pine. Thence N. W. W. 200 feet to another pine corner 81.87 feet to a yellow pine, thence N. W. 200 feet to the beginning being a part of Lot No. 16 said Lot 16 being shown in plat recorded in Plat Book "B," page 27, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. D. Meekel by deed dated May 12th, 1925 and recorded in the R. M. C.
