in consideration of the sum of Ten. (\$10.00)

And Other valuable Considerations,
to me paid by Mary Lewis Alston.

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mary Lewis Alston,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 14, of the property of Mary B. Lewis, as shown on plat recorded in the plat Book "F" page 136, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Aberdeen Avenue, point corner of Lots nos. 13 and 14 and running thence with the line of Lot no. 13 N. 62-50 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 27-10 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-00 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Aberdeen Avenue; thence with Aberdeen Avenue S. 27-10 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning; being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Mary B. Lewis by deed dated June 28, 1923, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in volume 88, page 283, in which deed the front and rear lines of said lot were erroneously described as 72 feet instead of 70 feet as shown on said plat and as set forth in the above description.

Nevertheless upon the following conditions, which conditions are part of the consideration for this deed and are expressly for the benefit of all owners of Lot 14 as shown on plat above referred to to-wit:
1. No building shall be erected nearer to the property line than 35 feet.
2. The property herein conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to a person of African descent. Any percentage of Negro blood.
3. The property herein conveyed shall never be used for other than residential purposes and no residence costing less than \$4,000.00 shall be erected thereon.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by on the day of 1926, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book , Page .
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, here heirs and assigns forever.

AND I myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary Lewis Alston, her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
