One those two certain Pieces, Parcels of later of land in the County and State aforesaid being a portion of the Warren B. Hunt Place on the Saluda River and being known and designated upon plat of same made by D. W. James, Engineer May 31, 1920; as Lots No. 8 and 8A, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Lot No. 8 being at a Point corner of lot No. 8 & 8A and running thence N. 74-30 E. 16.35 to a point in the Greenville-Pickens Roads; thence with said road to a point in center of said road; thence leaving said road and running S. 16 E. 2.94 to a stake; thence S. 6-30 W. 138 to a Stake; thence N. 65-30 E. 231 to White Oak; thence S. 77-15 W. 110 to Point; thence S. 45 W. 66 to Point; thence S. 59 W. 1.41 to Point; thence S. 71 W. 1.32 to Point; thence S. 86-30 W. 175 to Point; thence S. 34 W. 66 to a Sycamore on the bank of Saluda River; thence along said Saluda River to a point at corner of lot No. 1, leaving said river and running thence N. 76-30 E. along the southern lines of lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 to the beginning corner and containing 56 and eight-tenths acres more or less.
